- Co-led an **AI-powered migration across Meta's Hack codebase** spanning 120+ AI-generated codemods and 20k+ diffs; reduced lint violations from 248k to 174k.
- Built a deterministic evaluator to verify that an AI code-review assistant followed the required action order. Redesigned prompts, improving issue resolution **62% relative to control in A/B-tested benchmarks**.
- Self-initiated **Arty, a live-data dashboard platform** integrating 3 internal data systems; solo-built its first usable version in ~2 weeks. Generally available internally, with 500 distinct users over 7 days (as of Aug. 19, 2026).
- Identified query failures concentrated in one coding agent through telemetry; refined its CLI workflow instructions, reducing **malformed-query failures 38%**.
- Built observability for Meta's Rust build system serving tens of thousands of engineers; the work contributed to a **49% reduction in release-engineering operator load**.
- Cut daily build failures **48% (75→39/day)** by discovering an unobserved Ctrl-C failure pattern and implementing fail-fast error propagation in the core Rust binary.
- Authored internal AI workflow instructions with **39k installs**; designed multi-agent feedback loops for autonomous research workflows.
- Owned build-system operational health across 13 oncall rotations; **led a SEV1 investigation and cross-team response**.
